## **Gladys Rowena Moore**

**F**RAZEYSBURG – Gladys Rowena Moore, 94, of Nashport, Ohio died Saturday morning, April 23, 2011 at her home.

Born June 20, 1916 in Adamsville, Ohio she was the daughter of the late Charles R. and Maggie Alice (Hardesty) Wisecarver. Mrs. Moore was a member of the Nashport-Irville United Methodist Church. For many years she was head cook at old Nashport School and she retired from Good Samaritan Medical Center where she had been head cook for 27 years. She enjoyed living in the country watching the wildlife and spending time with her family.

Surviving are two daughters, Marlene (Jerome) Durant and Della M. Moore, both of Nashport; one son Ben T. (Rebecca) Moore, Jr. of Nashport; seven grandchildren; several great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by husband, Benjamin T.
