FRAZEYSBURG – Kenneth W. Denman, 87, of Zanesville, Ohio died Monday evening, April 11, 2011 at Genesis Morrison House, Zanesville.

Born July 9, 1923 in Dresden, Ohio he was the son of the late Lester J. and Lola M. (Wiles) Denman and was a 1941 graduate of Lash High School. Mr. Denman was a veteran of World War II where he served in the European Theater with the U. S. Army. He was owner and operator of Kenneth Denman Builders. Mr. Denman was a member of First Christian Church of Zanesville, a life member of Sertoma and a member of Lafayette Lodge #79, F. & A. M.

Surviving is his wife of 67 years, M. Lois (Barkhurst) Denman whom he married August 6, 1943; two sons and daughters in-law, Ted W. and Lee Ann Denman of Edgewood, Kentucky and Mark W. and Sandra Leah Denman of Garrettsville, Ohio; two grandchildren, Kathy L.
