## Mary Ann Casey

**F**RAZEYSBURG – Mary Ann Casey, 75, of Frazeyburg, Ohio died Saturday morning, March 26, 2011 at her home.

Born August 24, 1935 in Hopewell Township of Muskingum County she was the daughter of the late Roy C. and F. Ruth (Johnson) Ardrey and was a 1953 graduate of Frazeyburg High School. Mrs. Casey was also a 1957 graduate of The Ohio State University with a degree in education. She retired in 1994 from the Coshocton City Schools where she had taught for many years. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Newark, the Master Gardeners Association of Muskingum County and Over Eaters Anonymous of Zanesville. She love sewing, crafts, gardening, flowers and farming and for many years she judged baking and sewing projects at the Muskingum County Fair.

Surviving are two daughters, Cindy L. Evans of St. Louisville, Ohio and Elizabeth “Beth” (Joe) Greene of Zanesville; two grandchildren Michelle (Matthew) Royer of Mt. Vernon, Ohio and Renee Fox of Zanesville; one great grandchild, Ethan Royer; one brother, James R.
