F RAZEYSBURG – Frank L. Hiles, 79, of Avondale died Thursday morning, March 3, 2011 in the emergency room of Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital, Zanesville, Ohio.

Born January 14, 1932 in Zanesville he was the son of the late Francis M. and Anna (Parsons) Hiles and he was an Army veteran of the Korean War. He also served ten years in the Army National Guard. Mr. Hiles was a retired employee of Greif Brothers Corporation and he served for many years with the South Zanesville Volunteer Fire Department.
