FRAZEYSBURG – Joy L. Brailer, 81, of Nashport, Ohio died Monday evening, January 3, 2011 at Cedar Hill Care Center, Zanesville.

Born November 8, 1929 in Zanesville, she was the daughter of the late Claude and Mildred (Kirby) Archer and was a 1948 graduate of St. Thomas High School. Mrs. Brailer was a homemaker and a member St. Mary's Catholic Church at Mattingly Settlement. She was a poll worker for Licking Township for several years.
