FRAZEYSBURG – Wilma N. Bradley, 85, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio went home to be with the Lord, Wednesday afternoon, December 29, 2010 at Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born July 13, 1925 in Coshocton County, Ohio, she was the daughter of the late Lewis R. and Elnora C. (Welsh) Stotts and was a 1943 graduate of Jefferson High School in Dresden, Ohio. Wilma was a strong believer in Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. As a servant of the Lord, she held many positions at the Muskingum Presbyterian Church where she was a life-long member. They included Elder, Deacon, Sunday School teacher, choir member, Clerk of Session, member and past president of the Presbyterian Women's Association, Women's Prayer Group and the Cemetery Board. Mrs. Bradley was a former operator and supervisor for Ohio Bell Telephone, and later, she was head cook at Frazeytsburg Schools for many years. She was also a homemaker.
