Mary Ellen Hahn, 93, of Dresden, died Sunday evening, July 13, 2025, with her loving family at her side at Clay Gardens Place, Zanesville. Born April 21, 1932, in Muskingum County, she was a daughter of the late George and Virginia (Shaw) McGlade and a 1950 graduate of Jefferson High School.

Mary Ellen was a banker and loan officer at First Trust and Savings, now known as Park National Bank in Dresden. She worked there for 45 years, extending loans and making dreams a reality for many people in her community. She was a lifelong member of Dresden United Methodist Church, where she held the financial secretary position for the church over 50 years.

Mary Ellen loved all animals, reading, and tending to her vegetable garden and flower beds.
