Glenn Woodrow Mitchell, age 91, of Warsaw, Ohio died Tuesday afternoon, April 29, 2025.

Born October 13, 1933, he was a son of the late June Edward and Rosa Belle (Adams) Mitchell. Glenn was a self-taught machinist at Rockwell International of Newark, Ohio where he retired in 1988.
