Jean Carol Bathrick, 80, of Dresden, died Monday evening, March 17, 2025, surrounded by her family, at Genesis Hospital Emergency Room, Zanesville.

Born November 13, 1944, in East Palestine, Ohio, she was a daughter of the late Ray and Wilma (Welch) Hulton and a 1962 graduate from East Palestine High School. She went on to earn her degree in nursing from Youngstown Hospital's School of Nursing.

Jean was a registered nurse for 12 years at Bethesda Hospital, Zanesville. After retirement, she dedicated her love, time and energy to being the best mother and grandmother. Her grandchildren were her proudest achievements.
