# Michael Douglas Stirling

SEP 20, 1939 - JAN 4, 2025

**M**ichael Douglas Stirling, 85, of Frazeysburg, Ohio passed away peacefully, Saturday morning, January 4, 2025 at his home.

He was born September 20, 1939 in Los Angeles, California, to the late Douglas M. and Ruth (Fotheringham) Stirling. He retired from IBM as an Administration Manager. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Zanesville and faithfully served numerous full-time missions for his church. He also participated in the Boy Scouts of America as a youth (Eagle Scout) and volunteered as a youth leader throughout his adult life.
