Cynthia "Cindy" A. Kalb, 71, of Nashport, Ohio died early Wednesday morning, June 26, 2024, at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville, OH.

Born February 10, 1953, in Zanesville, she was a daughter of the late Kenneth E. & Margaret A. (Wilson) Thress and a 1971 Graduate of Brookhaven High School.

After graduation, Cindy obtained her Bachelor of Music from Capitol University in 1974. After spending 18 years as a devoted homemaker and excellent mother to her children, she taught music at all four of the Tri-Valley Elementary Schools.
