Harley Ray Noland 86, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Monday evening, May 13, 2024, peacefully at home surrounded by his loving family. Born October 15, 1937, in Wills Creek, Ohio he was a son of the late Pearl ("PG") and Ella M. (Pfeiffer) Noland and graduated high school while proudly serving in the U.S. Navy on the U.S.S. Krishna ARL-38. He was a machinist in the U.S. Navy for six years and later worked and retired from American National Can. While working for American National Can, Harley took great pride in helping design and build the machine used to make Playtex bottle liners.
