## **Wayne C. Eddleblute**

**W**ayne C. Eddleblute, 83, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Saturday morning, January 6, 2024 at his home.

Born October 20, 1940 in Roseville, Ohio he was a son of the late Virgil and Ruby I. (Rowland) Eddleblute and was a 1958 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School.

Following high school Wayne proudly served our country in the U. S. Navy from 1958 to 1962, serving aboard the USS Hector. He later received his bachelor's degree in business from Ohio State University and a master's degree from Troy State University.

He retired in 1996 from the Newark Air Force Base after 34 years of service. Wayne was a member and former Elder of Meadow View Church of Christ in Frazeytsburg and was a member and secretary of the Newark Chapter of Gideons International.

He was also a member of American Legion Post 399 of Dresden and Newark Chapter 310 of National Active and Retired Federal Employees where he served as Chaplain. Surviving is his loving wife of 52 years, Catherine L. (Hanby) Eddleblute whom he married December 18, 1971;
