James "Jim" Alfred Roman, 74, of Trinway, died Friday evening, December 8, 2023, at Genesis Hospital, Zanesville. Born June 20, 1949, in Zanesville, he was the son of late Alfred and Adlena (Wright) Roman and a 1967 graduate of Tri-Valley High School.

Jim retired from the Dresden Feed Mill after 45 years of service and 35 years of serving as a Cass Township Trustee. Jim was a lifetime member of the Trinway United Methodist Church, where he currently was serving as church trustee. He was involved in the Central Republican Committee, Muskingum County Sheep Committee and Ohio Suffolk Association.
