**C**harles R. "Dick" Martin, 81 of Lakeland, FL and formerly Newark, OH. passed away peacefully September 23, 2023 at Lakeland Regional Hospital.

He was born August 2, 1942 in Newark to the late Glen E. and Ida R. (Jinks) Martin. He served in the U. S. Navy during the Vietnam Era from 1959 to 1963. He trained as an Electrician and Fireman. He served on the USS Randolph and USS Currituck during the 1961-1962 Far East Cruise. He received an honorable discharge in August 1963.

He was employed for 28 years at Rockwell International/Meritor. While at Rockwell he was the first graduate of the Electrician Apprenticeship Program to become a qualified Electrician Journeyman. Mr. Martin was a member and Past Master of Newark Masonic Lodge #554 F&AM of which he states brought him a lot of joy.

He was a lifetime member of the Buckeye Lake FOE, American Legion Post # 104 Pinellas Park for 15 years, a member and helped establish the Buckeye Lake Royal Order of the Moose.
