Friends and family may call two hours prior to the service from 11 a.m. to 1p.m. at the funeral home, 1850 W. Main Street, Newark.



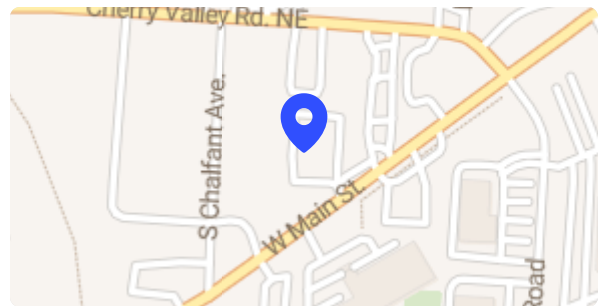

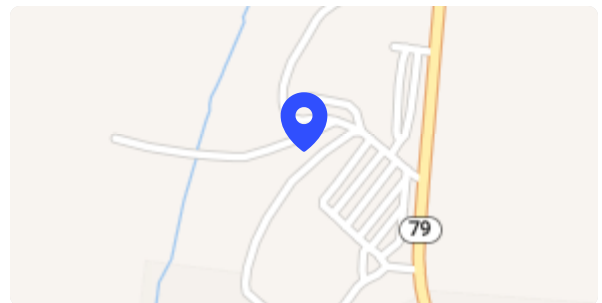
